Although not part of the Department of Corrections, the Department of Corrections strongly encourages this service to families, recognizing the great importance of family support to inmates.

Matthew House programs do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed or national origin. Matthew House was founded on the Matthew 25 principle that:

*“When I was hungry, you fed me, when I was thirsty, you gave me water, when I was a stranger you took me in, when I was naked, you clothed me, when I was sick you looked after me, when I was in prison, you visited me.”*

Supportive, non- judgmental and caring support is offered by all the staff. We are always available for someone to come in and share their hearts. All sharing of information is always confidential .

**Special Restrictions**

Overnight Accommodations are available to “women & children” traveling long distances. We have 3 apartments for women and children to stay in while visiting prison. **Reservations must be made in advance and lodging is limited to space available.**
